INDIGENOUS BURSARIES

The Indigenous Bursary covers all or part of the basic tuition costs and it is renewable each year up to Year 12, subject to continued academic endeavours.

- Reference from your current school Principal or Class Teacher.
- Attend an interview with the Bunbury Catholic College Principal.

P & F BURSARIES

The P & F Bursary is a \$600 grant to assist parents offset some of the costs associated with secondary school. It is a needs-based bursary and is payable only on the first year of secondary school.
