SELECTION CRITERIA

The successful candidate will:

- Be a practicing Catholic fully supportive of the ethos and objectives of Catholic Education Western Australia
- Be free of any impediment to full acceptance by the Catholic Church
- Possess highly developed organisational and interpersonal skills with a successful record of developing positive relationships with staff, students, and parents
- Demonstrate the capacity to lead prayer and work to promote the mission and life of the Catholic Church
- Demonstrate the ability to plan school liturgies, retreats (for students and staff), prayer services and community Masses
- Be able to oversee the Christian Service Learning (CSL) program as delivered by the CSL Coordinator
- Be able to implement school-wide and classroom opportunities for students to participate in faith formation, in collaboration with the Head of Learning Area: Religious Education
- Demonstrate the capacity to work as a member of a team
- Hold a minimum of a four-year tertiary qualification (including appropriate educational qualifications)
- Demonstrate success as a dynamic, innovative and reflective teaching practitioner (with a minimum of 5 years' experience) who strives for excellence.
- Develop spirit and character within the Houses context.
